



Recycling Financial Incentive for Multi-Family Housing Units

Offered by Preble County Solid Waste District

The Preble County Solid Waste District is offering a financial incentive for multi-family housing units intended to provide them with funding to start a property-wide recycling collection program. The District will work with the property owner(s) to provide up to \$1,500.00 in incentive funding to those complexes that desire to initiate recycling efforts. The funding can be used to offset costs for recycling collection. Some guidelines apply such as the multi-family housing unit is required to enter into an agreement with the Solid Waste District, the property owner must agree to continue to work with the County to ensure the success of the program including reporting any problems to the County, and the multi-family housing unit must continue to fund the recycling program for a minimum of at least two additional years.
